PROVE UP BY AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES CHECKLIST

The party or parties to a prove-up must supply certain documentation in order to satisfy the Illinois Marriage and Dissolution of Marriage Act, state and local court procedural rules. **Some documents may or may not be required depending on the facts in each case. Necessary forms can be found at https://services.cookcountyclerkofcourt.org/Forms** The following checklist, designed for use in Cook County, is offered as a tool to help litigants and clerks ensure the correct documentation is in order for a case to be ready for prove-up.
