Whereas, the Office of the Chief Judge employees have experienced 150 covid-19 cases:

Whereas, the undersigned Presiding Judge is trying to keep all Judges, Office of the Chief Judge personnel, Clerks of the Court, and Stakeholders in the Domestic Violence Courthouse safe.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That effective Monday, November 23, 2020 and until further order of the court, there shall be no in-person hearings or trials heard or conducted by any of the criminal courtroom Judges at the Domestic Violence Courthouse.
- 2. The criminal court Judges shall not reschedule any in-person hearings or trials until the outcome of this in-person shutdown is lifted.

This order is entered this 24th day of November, 2020, and shall be spread of record, and circulated to all Sheriffs, State's Attorneys, Public Defenders, all Domestic Violence Stakeholders, and private attorneys.
