September 1, 2021 shall be continued and heard remotely on -- September 21, 2021

The Clerk of the Court shall enter into the Clerk's case management system the above continued dates and transmit to the Sheriff the disposition orders for entry into the LEADS system for all emergency orders of protection, emergency stalking no contact orders, and emergency civil no contact orders that are being extended to the remote/zoom dates provided above.

Motions to vacate dismissals and to reinstate Emergency Orders of Protection for cases dismissed on a party's failure to appear in a rescheduled case under this Order shall be liberally construed by the judge presiding over the case.

The Clerk of the Court shall send out post cards to all litigants with the continued remote/zoom court dates as set forth above.
