SUBJECT: Place of holding court, office hours and location of the circuit clerk

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, on Saturday, September 28, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., at Malcom X College, 1900 W. Jackson Blvd., Chicago, IL 60612, Rooms 1101, 1102, and 1103, the circuit clerk of Cook County is authorized to accept the filing of the following petitions or motions by defendants who have pre-registered to have their cases heard at said time and place:

- 1. request for relief related to reinstatement of the defendant's driver's license that does not require the scheduling of a court date; or
- 2. leave to sue or defend as an indigent person in the matters described above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, at said time, 1101, 1102, and 1103 at Malcom X College, 1900 W. Jackson Blvd., Chicago, IL 60612, are hereby designated as places of holding court for the limited purpose of hearing and ruling on petitions or motions asking the circuit court for relief related to reinstatement of the defendant's driver's license;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in any case in which the defendant is represented by the Public Defender, or was previously represented by the Public Defender and is not currently represented by private counsel, the Public Defender shall be deemed appointed by the court as defense counsel for purposes of these proceedings, pending appearance before the court;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any circuit judge or associate circuit judge, regardless of his or her judicial assignment, may adjudicate said petitions and motions filed at said time and place. Dated this 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 2024.
